The St Mary's Centre Annual Symposium, 22-24 October 2013

We would like to invite you to the St Mary's Centre Annual Symposium for 2013. We hope that you will be able to attend and contribute a paper. The symposium will begin with lunch at around 12.30pm on 22 October and close after lunch on 24 October.

Location

The symposium will be held at Noddfa, Conwy Old Road, Penmaenmawr, North Wales, LL34 6YF. Website: www.noddfa.org.uk The nearest train station is Penmaenmawr, from where you can be collected by a member of staff, if this is arranged in advance. Alternatively, taxis are available from Llandudno Junction (£7.50).

Costings

The full residential cost for the symposium is **£110**, which includes accommodation and all meals. On-site places are limited to 30 participants, but there are additional bed and breakfast options nearby.

- a seminar of around 60 minutes to present research findings (presentation of no more than 40 minutes, followed by discussion)
- or
- a seminar of around 30 minutes to present research plans (presentation of no more than 15 minutes, followed by discussion)

Please note the distinction between the two types of presentation. Participants are also usually asked to chair a session.

Abstracts

Intention to offer a presentation should be indicated on your booking form, and abstracts should be emailed to **Tania ap Sion** (t.apsion@glyndwr.ac.uk) by **31 July 2013** at the latest. No papers or abstracts will be accepted after this date.
